The process of Certification is to keep practitioners and instructors current and engaged in best practice within the field of Energy Medicine.

HTCP certification involves a rigorous process of study, testing and peer-reviewed evaluation that is designed and administered by specialists in the area of Healing Touch as an Energy modality.

Population Being Served: Target audience includes nurses, healthcare professionals, and interested laypeople that have a desire to provide Healing Touch in a private practice, hospitals and healthcare settings. Our population is generally located in North America but is also growing worldwide.

Credential Issues: Healing Touch Certification Governing Committee (HTCGC) awards the credential Healing Touch Certified Practitioner (HTCP) to those individuals meeting the educational, testing and peer-reviewed evaluation requirements for professional certification.

Note: Healing Touch Certified Instructor (HTCI) is not an accredited credential, but is administered by Healing Touch Certification.

The Healing Touch Certified Practitioner Entry Level Proficiency Exam (HTCP ELPE)

The exam is geared towards an entry level HTCP. It is a Multiple Choice criterion referenced exam consisting of one-hundred questions, eighty questions are exam questions and are scored, and twenty

questions are pilot questions and are not included in the reported exam score. The exam is only given in a secure location with a qualified proctor. The applicant (herein applicant or candidate) has three hours to complete the exam, which is offered as a paper and pencil test, or as a computer based test. The exam is a closed book test. The completed exam is returned to Healing Touch Certification (HTC) where it is scored mechanically. The score is reported to the applicant as the percentage of correct responses, out of the total number of questions within ten business days of return of the completed exam materials. The Exam started on August 2, 2012.

Pilot Test: All exam questions are tested in an actual exam setting under conditions consistent with those established for the exam. The responses of actual HTCPs to these pilot questions help determine which questions are suitable for inclusion on the exam. The pilot test was 180 questions and once the cut score was validated the test were rescored as the exam. The pilot test was offered from 11/10/2011 – 2/27/2012

Grandfather Period: The Healing Touch Certification Governing Committee granted a grandfather period for previous credential holders, which was closed December 31, 2012.

Combined Total of 882 Exams and Pilot Tests have been completed through 2015

The Exam cut score, or minimum score required to pass the exam is 73%

Exam Reliability

The reliability for the HTCP ELPE, as measured by Cronbach's Alpha for the exam results between August 2012 and December 31, 2015, for a total of 587 exams, was $\alpha=0.898$. For 2015 only $\alpha=0.918$

Standard Error of Measure (SEM) for the HTCP ELPE

The average score SEM for 2015 only was 2.8 for the raw score, and 3.1 for the scaled score.

The average score SEM for the 2012-2015 was 3.0 for the raw score, and 3.3 for the scaled score.

The SEM for the minimum passing score was 3.9 for the raw score and 4.4 for the scaled score.
